



High Hopes Scholarship Program

High Hopes offers a limited number of full or partial scholarships to children whose families demonstrate financial need. Determination of eligibility and the amount of each scholarship granted will be decided by the High Hopes Board of Directors.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, families must complete the attached application and provide the following applicable documents to establish financial need (your file will be kept confidential):

- The two most recent pay stubs for all employed adult family members
- Most recent tax return or statement of annual income
- Unemployment income statements
- Assistance documents such as Social Security
- List of other income, including child support and/or alimony income
- List of monthly expenses and average amount of each (mortgage/rent, car payments, utilities, credit card payments, child support, etc.)

High Hopes Scholarship Policies:

1. A limited number of **full or partial** scholarships will be given, based on the availability of funds, to families who demonstrate a financial need.
 2. Scholarship need will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis using information on the application and the financial documentation provided by the applicant.
 3. Scholarships will be granted on a first come, first served basis.
 4. Scholarships may be awarded short or long term.
 5. All scholarship decisions will be at the sole discretion of the High Hopes Ministry Board of Directors, with consideration given to input by the program directors.
 6. The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel or reduce any scholarship, at any time, for any reason. However, the program must provide the family with 30 day's advance written notice of intent to change the scholarship terms.
 7. All tuition payments must be made in accordance with High Hopes policies, and any past due amount will cause the scholarship to be cancelled.
 8. Families must reapply for scholarships each year, and no family may receive a scholarship for more than two years.
 9. Financial status and special circumstances will be reevaluated at a minimum of once per semester, and families may be asked at any time to resubmit financial eligibility documentation in order to continue receiving scholarships. [Failure to comply with this request will result in scholarship termination]. Scholarship recipients must immediately report any changes in income or special circumstances to the High Hopes Director.
